Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever is dedicated to the conservation of pheasants, quail and other wildlife through habitat improvements, public awareness, education and land management policies and programs.

A Unique Model

At the heart of "The Habitat Organization" is a unique model empowering chapters of Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever with 100 percent decision-making control over their locally raised funds – the only national conservation organization that operates through this truly grassroots structure. As a result, local chapter volunteers conduct wildlife habitat projects and conservation education events in their own communities, while belonging to a national organization with a voice regarding federal and state conservation policy.

A Diverse Membership

Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever members are a diverse group of hunters, farmers, ranchers, landowners, conservation enthusiasts, and wildlife officials. The common thread is all want to make a difference for wildlife by conserving, improving or creating upland habitat.

Local Chapters

There are currently 574 Pheasants Forever chapters and 169 Quail Forever chapters across the U.S. and Canada, accounting for over 145,000 members.

Our Work

Wildlife Habitat Projects –

The system of empowering local chapters and volunteers to make the best decisions for wildlife in their local area has resulted in the average annual completion of 15,000 projects. Since Pheasants Forever's inception in 1982 and Quail Forever's launch in 2005, the organization's wildlife habitat projects have benefited over 17 million acres across the continent. In that time, the organization has participated in more than 1,522 different land acquisitions, totaling more than 194,000 acres of permanently protected habitat. Those land acquisition projects have been completed in conjunction with local, state and federal natural resource agencies and are all open to public hunting.

Habitat Conservation Advocacy –

Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever's mission is directly tied to a strong framework of federal conservation programs. Authority for critical conservation programs, such as the Conservation Reserve Program is granted by the U.S. Congress in the Federal Farm Bill's Conservation Title. In total, federal farm conservation programs allow Pheasants Forever and partners to help manage nearly 52 million acres for wildlife habitat.

Conservation Education –

Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever have developed programs and materials that promote conservation education and public awareness, including its No Child Left Indoors initiative.

Federal Premium is proud to announce it has surpassed a total of 50 million shotgun shells sold in support of Pheasants Forever, the nation's leading upland habitat conservation organization. These special shells are all sold in boxes marked with the Pheasants Forever logo, as part of an on-box royalty program.

Federal Premium (headquartered in Anoka, MN) and Pheasants Forever's on-box royalty program began in 1998 with Federal Premium's Pheasants Forever-labeled Wing-Shok shotgun shell boxes. The program evolved in 2010 with the revolutionary Prairie Storm specialty pheasant load, and it continued to grow in 2011 with the introduction of Prairie Storm FS Steel. A portion of the proceeds from each Pheasants Forever logoed box sold goes directly to the conservation group's wildlife habitat efforts, contributing to sustainable pheasant populations and increased upland hunter participation.

Choosing to purchase a box of Federal Premium's shotgun shells marked with the Pheasants Forever logo is one more way hunters can contribute to upland conservation efforts and ensure future generations can enjoy the rich tradition of upland hunting.



GET A FREE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR YOUR PROPERTY

The Habitat Help Desk is an area of the show floor dedicated to helping landowners meet their habitat goals. Landowners can consult with trained wildlife biologists on how to improve their acres for wildlife habitat, as well as what local, state, and federal conservation programs their properties qualify for.

HERE'S HOW:

- Bring the legal description of your property (township, range, and section) or have the ability to pinpoint your property's exact location on the map
- Sit down with a trained wildlife biologist from Pheasants Forever and Quail Forever to review your habitat goals and find out what financial and technical programs are available to help you accomplish them
- Leave with a free wildlife habitat management plan for your land

WHY HABITAT?

Two factors affect pheasant and quail populations above all others—habitat and weather. While we can't control the weather, we can influence the quality and quantity of upland habitat. Habitat is what supports long-term strong and healthy pheasant and quail populations.

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
