Chapter-Level Matching Grant Funding

How the Matching Fund Works

The WOTW Matching Grant Fund can be accessed in one of two ways:

Option 1: Matching P2U Learn to Hunt (LtH) or Learn to Shoot (LtS) Grants

1. A chapter applies for and receives an eligible P2U grant (up to \$500 reimbursement) for a women-focused LtH or LtS event.
2. Upon confirmation of the P2U reimbursement, WOTW provides a **matching award** to supplement the original grant.

Example: A chapter receives a \$500 LtH or LtS grant for a women's focused event. The chapter is then eligible to receive a WOTW matching award of up to \$500, effectively doubling the funding available for the event.

Option 2: Alternative Women-Focused Events

1. A chapter hosts an alternative, non-fundraising women-focused event that aligns with Women on the Wing goals (e.g., Women, Wine, and Wild Game; skill-building workshops; social or educational engagement events).
2. The chapter applies to Women on the Wing for reimbursement and may receive up to \$500 in WOTW grant funding.

This option allows flexibility for chapters that are engaging women outside of the LtH and LtS framework, while still maintaining accountability and impact reporting.

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for funding, chapters must meet the following requirements:

For LtH or LtS Matching Grants:

- Successfully submit and receive P2U grant reimbursement for a women focused Learn to Hunt or Learn to Shoot event

- Submit a post-event story and photos via the “Share Your Story” JotForm on the WOTW landing page. These submissions also make chapters eligible for potential feature consideration in a future WOTW section of the journal.

For Alternative Women-Focused Events (non-fundraisers):

Complete a post-event story and photo submission via the [“Share Your Story” JotForm](#). The JotForm submission serves as the sole reporting requirement for alternative event funding requests.

Selection & Administration

Application Review:

- LtH and LtS matching grants will be reviewed and approved by Ashley Chance as part of the existing P2U grant process.
- Alternative event applications will be reviewed and approved by Lexi Ashbrook.

Award Process:

- Grants are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available.
- Rolling reviews allow chapters to move forward without long approval delays.

Reporting and Oversight:

- Chapters will provide a brief post-event summary focused on impact and funds leveraged.
- WOTW will track participation, funding distribution, and outcomes to inform future programming and fundraising efforts.
- Applications and fund usage will be monitored, and the opportunity will be promoted as long as funds remain available.
